

SECURITY

It is the responsibility of the Board of Education to safeguard *its* grounds, buildings, and facilities from harm and/or damage and to prevent injury to the children and/or other persons duly authorized to use the same. The buildings, grounds, and outdoor facilities are "off limits" to all unauthorized persons between the time periods of dusk and dawn daily. The Board requires the Superintendent to arrange appropriate measures for building security.

The Old Tappan Board of Education urges members of the community, students, and staff members to cooperate in reporting any violation of this policy, or incidents of vandalism to property belonging to the Old Tappan School District and the name of the person or persons believed to be responsible.

The Old Tappan Board of Education authorizes the use of video surveillance in order to promote and enhance the physical safety and security of students, staff, authorized visitors and buildings.
