

DESIGNING / ARCHITECTURAL / ENGINEERING SERVICES

All plans and specifications for significant school building work of any nature, by law, must be prepared by an architect, a mechanical engineer, or structural engineer registered to practice in the State of New Jersey and be within the limits covered by such registration.

The Board of Education's criteria for the selection of architects and engineers to be employed by the school District will be such as to ensure a high degree of competency and responsiveness to the needs of the Board and the District. Selection of architects and engineers for each major alteration, addition or new building project will use the Board of Education's screening and selection process.
